



Summary: HMS Theatre typically starts meeting on Wednesday during the months of October to December. During that time, participants will develop their acting, speaking, and improvisational skills each meeting by engaging in lessons lead by Mrs. Burrows. In December, auditions will be held within the HMS Theatre Department to cast for the Spring Musical performance which is held in May at HHS. **A Musical requires a lot of work and commitment.** Therefore, after the musical's cast is chosen, a rehearsal schedule will be released which will require **most** performers to meet **two to four days a week-Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday** from 2:15-4:30 **and some Fridays until 5:30.**

Events: Drama Lessons developing acting, speaking, and improvisational skills and A Spring Musical Performance.

Expectations: Being a member of the HMS Theatre family requires members (and their families) to be fully committed to the process of preparing for the performances. Participation typically prevents and/or limits students from being a part of other clubs or after school programs. Attendance to all scheduled rehearsals and all performances is required in order to participate in the program.
